

Mystery Quilt 2018 - Step six – June – Largest design continued

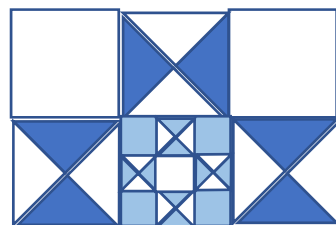
1. Option 1 planned - Use the fabric-1 of your color pair 5. Cut 24 (32) squares $5\frac{3}{4} \times 5\frac{3}{4}$ inches.
2. Option 2- scrappy- Choose 12 (16) fabrics and from each cut two squares $5\frac{3}{4} \times 5\frac{3}{4}$ inches.
3. Both options – From Background fabric cut 24(32) squares $5\frac{3}{4} \times 5\frac{3}{4}$ inches.
4. Using the squares of background and fabric together make the 48 (64) star points of $\frac{1}{4}$ square triangles as you did for the small and medium units. See the diagrams and instructions in Step one – January.
5. DO NOT put the stars together yet. Save until step seven. There is another special technique.



Mystery Quilt 2018 - Step seven – July Large design continued.

1. From back ground fabric: Cut 24(32) squares 5×5 inches.
Cut 24 (32) rectangles $3\frac{1}{2} \times 5$ inches.
Cut 12 (16) rectangles $5 \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ inches.
2. Use the reversed color small stars from step 5, the last small stars from step 2, your star points from step 6 and the cut back ground pieces to make the following two units.
Make 12 (16) each. **Pay attention to the direction of the star 'points'.** Do not sew them together yet.
