## **General Rules and Instructions**

Location: Jarrettsville Volunteer Fire Company's Jarrettsville Gardens, 3825 Federal Hill Rd., Jarrettsville, MD 21084

**Quilt Registration**: August and September General Membership meetings, by email, or USPS. Please return your registration forms to Penny Swoyer, 391 Nace Road, Airville, PA 17302, patchwurk@yahoo.com, 717-817-7350.

Who Can Register: Any member in good standing of Quilting on the Line (QOL). There is no limit to the number of entries a member can register unless space becomes filled. We are accepting quilt art made since November 2019, the date of our last quilt show.

Registration Deadline: Registration forms must be submitted no later than Tuesday, October 3, 2023.

Registration Form and Description: Each entry must have a separate registration form (one registration form per entry). Compose a short description for each entry as you want it to appear on the display card at the show. It is important to include the measurements for your entry, type (king-size bed quilt, wall hanging, quilted handbag, etc.) who pieced and quilted it. Equally important is to include if it was a Mystery Quilt, Row-by-Row, Block of the Month (BOM), Quilt of Valor (QOV) or Challenge. We intend to display all quilts from QOL-sponsored activities together by category. If you do not have access to a computer, please clearly print a registration form obtained at the August or September meetings.

Entries for Sale: Any member wishing to sell an item must include their contact information to be used on the display card. This is NOT a QOL-sponsored program. All sales are between the seller and buyer. QOL will not be involved in any way.

**Quilt Pillowcase and Label**: Each entry must be in a separate pillowcase with the owner's name, address, and phone number on it. We strongly recommend you have a label or tag pinned on the back of your entry with your name on it. If it is a purse or a bag, please include a label or tag on the inside or bottom with your name. We treat every piece as if it was our own and want to ensure it is protected and well taken care of.

Quilt Drop Off: Friday, Nov. 3, 2023, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Jarrettsville Gardens. You may have someone else drop off your entry(s). They will not be accepted any other time or the day of the show. It takes the better part of the setup on Friday to properly organize and hang the quilt art.

**Keep Your Receipt**: When your entry(s) is dropped off, you will be given back your original registration form. The registration form is required to claim your item(s) on Sunday. You may have someone else pickup for you, but they will need your receipt to do so.

Exhibit Dates: Saturday, Nov. 4, 2023, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Sunday, Nov. 5, 2023, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Quilt Pickup: Sunday, Nov. 5, 2023, between 5 and 5:45 p.m. We appreciate your cooperation and patience in advance. We need an hour between the end of the show and the start of pickup in order to carefully take down the entries and organize them for return. Don't forget your receipt!
