- One, two, or three jpegs or photo prints (if you want to let me choose the best one) sent to Sharon McKnight at fern12@zoominternet.net by April 23 so she can scan and send me to prepare for your patterning
- Piece of fabric 12" x 14" for background over a same-size piece of batting, felt, or flannel
- Fabric scraps to match elements of your photo
- Pencil, scissors, pins, iron for sharing



What I'll provide for this workshop:

- An up-sized image for translating your photo to patterns
- Tracing paper
- Paper-backed fusible web
- Silk, satin, and metallic fabrics to add gleam, plus other textures to suggest for your art quilts
- Sheer fabrics for shadows
