2026 QOL Quilt Challenge Criteria

“TOTALLY SCRAPPY”

Goal: The goal of the 2026 Quilt Challenge is two-fold. One is to create a children’s quilt totally from scraps and /or material that you have in your stash. Two is to donate the quilts to Comfort for Kids charity with a club goal of 60 quilts.

Rules:

Size: 40” x 40” or 40” x 60” (Approximately -1 inch or two either direction is ok). Use all scraps/stash for top, batting, and backing. Even use up spools of thread and bobbins that are accumulating around your sewing area.

Do not buy anything new.

You can ask other members for scraps, batting pieces or backing if you need pieces and parts.

Two members can cooperate on a quilt and combine scraps, colors, and quilt ideas. There will be 4: \$25.00 prizes for each category. Quilts will be judged on the “Best and most creative use of scraps”.

This is meant to be a group challenge and not a secret challenge. The sizes are based on the needs of the two charity organizations that we give the quilts to. One caters to children under 3. The other has children from 6 to 13. Think preteens. Think of colors and unique designs. Ask grandchildren, nieces, and nephews etc. what they would like. Go outside your comfort zone. Challenge yourself with the scraps that you have.
